10th Scroll — 12th year (585
B.C.)

Prophecy regarding
Jerusalem's Destruction

→ 5th day

(33:21) And it was in the twelfth
year of our exile, in the tenth
month, on the fifth of the
month, one who escaped out of
Jerusalem came to me, saying,
The city is stricken. See, Ch
24:27, 3:25-26

Ezekiel no longer dumb

(32:22) And Yahweh's hand was
on me *in the evening* (4th),
*before he who had escaped
came. And He had opened my
mouth until he came to me in
the morning; and my mouth
was opened, and I was dumb
no more.* (See scroll one and
four)

(33:23) And the Word of
Yahweh came to me, saying,
(33:24) Son of man, those who
live in those wastes of the land of
Israel are speaking, saying,
Abraham was one, and he
inherited the land. But we are
many; the land is given to us for
inheritance.

(33:25) So say to them, So says
the Lord Yahweh: You eat with
the blood, and lift up your eyes to
your idols, and shed blood; and
shall you possess the land?
(33:26) You stand on your sword,
you work abomination, each
defiling his neighbor's wife. And
shall you possess the land?

(33:27) Speak to them in this way,
So says the Lord Yahweh: As I
live, surely those who are in the
ruins shall fall by the sword, and I
will give him who is in the open
field to the beasts to be eaten up,
and those in the forts and in the
caves shall die of the plague.
(33:28) For I have made the land
a ruin, and the pride of her
strength has ceased. And the
mountains of Israel shall be a
waste, so that none shall pass
through. (33:29) **And they shall
know that I am Yahweh,** when I
have made the land a ruin
because of all their abominations,
which they have committed.

((33:30) And you, son of man, the
sons of your people are still

talking about you by the walls,
and in the doors of the houses,
and speaking to one another,
each man to his brother, saying,
I pray you, come and hear what is
the Word which comes from
Yahweh. (33:31) And they come
to you as the people come, and
they sit before you as My people,
and they hear your words. But
they will not do them. For with
their mouth they show much love,
but their heart goes after their
unjust gain.

(33:32) **And lo, you are to them
as a singer of love songs with a
beautiful voice, and able to play
well on an instrument; for they
hear your words, but they do
not do them.** (33:33) **And when
this happens; lo, it will come;
then they shall know that a
prophet has been among them.**

Prophecy against the
shepherds of Israel

(34:1) **And the Word of Yahweh
came to me, saying,** (34:2) **Son
of man, prophecy against the
shepherds of Israel.** Prophecy
and say to them, So says the
Lord Yahweh to the shepherds:
Woe to the shepherds of Israel
who feed themselves! Should not
the shepherds feed the flocks?
(34:3) You eat the fat and clothe
yourselves with the wool; you kill
the fat ones, *but* you do not feed
the flock. (34:4) You have not
made the weak strong, nor have
you healed the sick, nor have you
bound up the broken. You have
not brought again those driven
away, nor have you sought that
which was lost; but you have
ruled them with force and with
cruelty. (34:5) And they were
scattered for lack of a shepherd.
And they became food to all the
beasts of the field when they were
scattered. (34:6) My sheep
wandered through all the
mountains and on every high hill.
Yea, My flock was scattered on all
the face of the earth, and none
searched nor sought for them.

(34:7) **Therefore, shepherds,
hear the Word of Yahweh:**

(34:8) As I live, says the Lord
Yahweh, surely because My flock
became a prey, and My flock
became food to every beast of the
field, because *there was* no
shepherd, nor did My shepherds
search for My flock, but the
shepherds fed themselves and
did not feed My flock, (34:9)
therefore, O shepherds, hear the

Word of Yahweh. (34:10) So says
the Lord Yahweh: Behold, I *am*
against the shepherds, and I will
require My flock at their hand, and
cause them to cease from feeding
the flock. Nor shall the shepherds
feed themselves any more; for I
will deliver My flock from their
mouth, and they will not be food
to devour

Promise of restoration

(34:11) **For so says the Lord
Yahweh: Behold, I Myself will
search for My sheep and seek
them out.** (34:12) As a shepherd
seeks out his flock *in the day
that he is among his scattered
sheep, so I will seek out My
sheep and will deliver them out
of all places where they have
been scattered in the cloudy
and dark day.*

(34:13) And I will bring them out
from the peoples, and gather
them from the lands, and will
bring them to their own land and
feed them on the mountain of
Israel by the rivers, and in all the
places of the land where people
live. (34:14) I will feed them in a
good pasture, and their fold shall
be on the high mountains of
Israel. There they shall lie in a
good fold, and *in* a fat pasture
they shall feed on the mountains
of Israel. (34:15) I will feed My
flock, and I will cause them to lie
down, says the Lord Yahweh.

(34:16) I will seek the lost, and
bring again those driven away,
and will bind up the broken, and
will strengthen the sick. But I will
destroy the fat and the strong; I
will feed them with judgment.
(34:17) And you, My flock, says
the Lord Yahweh: Behold, I judge
between lamb and lamb, *between
rams and he-goats.* (34:18) Is it a
small thing to you to have eaten
up the good pasture, but you
must trample the rest of your
pastures with your feet? And to
have drunk of the clear waters,
but you must foul the rest with
your feet? (34:19) And My flock,
they eat *what* your feet have
trampled, and they drink *what*
your feet have fouled.

(34:20) So the Lord Yahweh says
this to them: Behold I Myself will
even judge between the fat lamb
and the lean lamb. (34:21) Because
you have thrust with side and
with shoulder, and have pushed
all the weak with your
horns until you have scattered

them to the outside, (34:22) therefore I will save My flock, and they shall no more be a prey. **And I will judge between lamb and lamb.** (34:23) **And I will set up one Shepherd over them, and He shall feed them, My servant David. He shall feed them, and He shall be their Shepherd.** (34:24) **And I Yahweh will be their God, and My servant David a ruler among them.** I Yahweh have spoken.

(34:25) **And I will make a covenant of peace with them, and will send the evil beasts out of the land. And they shall dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods.** (34:26) And I will make them, and the places around My hill, a blessing; and I will bring down the shower in its season. **There shall be showers of blessing.** (34:27) **And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase. And they shall be safe in their land, and they shall know that I am Yahweh,** when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and have delivered them out of the hands of those who enslaved them. (34:28) And no more shall they be a prey to the nations, nor shall the beast of the land eat them. **But they shall dwell safely, and none shall terrify them.** (34:29) And I will raise up for them a noted planting place, and they shall never again be of those gathered by famine in the land, nor shall they bear the shame of the nations any more. (34:30) **And they shall know that I, Yahweh their God, am with them, and they, the house of Israel, are My people, says the Lord Yahweh.** (34:31) **And you My sheep, the sheep of My pasture, are men, and I am your God, says the Lord Yahweh.**

Prophecy against Mount Seir

(35:1) **And the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,** (35:2) Son of man, set your face against Mount Seir and prophesy against it. (35:3) And say to it, So says the Lord Yahweh: Behold, O Mount Seir, I am against you, and I will stretch out My hand against you, and I will make you a ruin and a waste. (35:4) I will raze your cities, and you shall be ruined, and you shall know that I am Yahweh. (35:5) Because you have had a never-ending hatred, and have shed *the blood of the*

sons of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time *that* iniquity *had* an end, (35:6) therefore, as I live, says the Lord Yahweh, I will yield you up to blood, and blood shall pursue you. Since you have not hated blood, even blood shall pursue you. (35:7) So I will make Mount Seir a ruin, and cut off from it the one passing through, and the one returning. (35:8) And I will fill his mountains *with* his dead. *In* your hills, and your valleys, and all your rivers, those slain with the sword shall fall in them. (35:9) I will make you ruins forever, and your cities shall not be inhabited. **And you shall know that I am Yahweh.**

(35:10) Because you have said, These two nations and these two lands shall be mine, and we shall possess it; yet Yahweh was there; (35:11) therefore, as I live, says the Lord Yahweh, I will act by your anger and by your envy which you have shown out of your hatred against them. And I will make Myself known among them when I have judged you. (35:12) And you shall know that I am Yahweh. I have heard all your blasphemies which you have spoken against the mountains of Israel, saying, Desolation! They are given to us for food. (35:13) So with your mouth you have boasted against Me, and have multiplied your words against Me. I have heard *them*. (35:14) So says the Lord Yahweh: When the whole earth rejoices, I will make you a ruin. (35:15) As you rejoiced at the inheritance of the **house of Israel** because of desolation, so I will do to you. You shall be desolation, O Mount Seir and all Idumea, even all of it. And they shall know that I am Yahweh.

Prophecy to the Mountains of Israel

(36:1) **Also, son of man, prophesy to the mountains of Israel, and say, Mountains of Israel, hear the Word of Yahweh.** (36:2) So says the Lord Yahweh: Because the enemy has said against you, Aha! Even the old high places have become a possession to us. (36:3) Therefore prophesy and say, So says the Lord Yahweh: Because of the wasting and crushing of you from all around, that you might be a possession to the rest

of the nations, and you were lifted up on the tip of the tongue, and the talking of the people; (36:4) so, mountains of Israel, hear the Word of the Lord Yahweh. So says the Lord Yahweh to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, to the deserted wastes, and to the cities that are forsaken, which became a prey and a mockery to the rest of the nations all around.

(36:5) So the Lord Yahweh says this: Surely in the fire of My jealousy I have spoken against the rest of the nations, and against all Idumea, who have given My land to themselves for a possession with all joy of heart, with scorning of soul, to make it open land for a prey.

So prophesy concerning the land of Israel

(36:6) So prophesy concerning the land of Israel, and say to the mountains and to the hills, to the rivers and to the valleys, So says the Lord Yahweh: Behold, I have spoken in My jealousy and in My fury, because you have borne the shame of the nations.

(36:7) Therefore so says the Lord Yahweh: I have lifted up My hand; surely the nations around you shall bear their shame. (36:8) **But you, O mountains of Israel, you shall put out your branches and yield your fruit to My people Israel; for they have drawn near to come.** (36:9) **For, behold, I am for you, and I will turn to you, and you shall be tilled and sown.** (36:10) **And I will multiply men on you, all the house of Israel, all of it. And the cities shall have people, and the wastes shall be built.** (36:11) **And I will multiply men and beast on you, and they shall increase and be fruitful. And I will make you dwell as before, and I will do better to you than at your beginnings. And you shall know that I am Yahweh.**

(36:12) Yea, I will cause men to walk on you, even My people Israel. And they shall possess you, and you shall be their inheritance, and not any more will increase their bereavement. **(And never again bereave them of children – NAS version.)**

(36:13) So says the Lord Yahweh: Because they say to you, You are a devourer of men, and you have₂

bereaved your nations; (36:14) so you shall devour men no more, nor shall you bereave your nations (of children – NAS version) any more, says the Lord Yahweh. (36:15) Nor will I allow you to hear the shame of the nations any more, nor shall you bear the shame of the peoples any more, nor shall you cause your nations to fall any more, **says the Lord Yahweh. Versus 12, 13, 14 and 15 possibly out of sequence?**

House of Israel defiled their land

(36:16) **And the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying.** (36:17) **Son of man, when the house of Israel lived in their own land,** they defiled it by their own way and by their doings, even as the defilement of woman's impurity, their way was before Me. (36:18) So I poured My fury on them, because of the blood that they had shed on the land, and for their idols *by which* they defiled it. (36:19) **And I scattered them among the nations, and they were scattered through the lands. I judged them according to their way and according to their doings.** (36:20) And when they entered the nations where they went, they even profaned My holy name by saying to them, These are the people of the Yahweh, and they are gone out of His land. (36:21) But I had pity for My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the nations where they went.

(36:22) Therefore say to the house of Israel, **So says the Lord Yahweh: I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name's sake, which you have profaned among the nations where you went.** (36:23) **And I will sanctify My great name, which was profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst. And the nations shall know that I am Yahweh, says the Lord Yahweh, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes.**

36:24 **For I** will take you from among the nations and gather you out of all lands, and will gather you into your own land. 36:25 And I will sprinkle clean waters on you, and you shall be clean. I will cleanse you from all

your filthiness and from your idols. 36:26 **And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit within you. And I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.** 36:27 And I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you shall keep My judgments and do *them*. 36:28 And you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers. **And you shall be My people, and I will be your God.** 36:29 I will also save you from all your defilements, and I will call for the grain, and will increase it, and will lay no famine on you. 36:30 **And I will multiply the fruits of the tree and the increase of the field, so that you shall never again receive the curse of famine among the nations.** 36:31 And you shall remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall despise yourselves in your own sight for your iniquities and for your abominations. 36:32 I do not do *this* for your sake, says the Lord Yahweh, be it known to you. **Be ashamed and confounded for your ways, O house of Israel.**

36:33 **So says the Lord Yahweh: In the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will also cause you to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be built. 36:34 And the waste land shall be tilled, instead of being a ruin before all passing by. And they shall say, This land that was wasted has become like the garden of Eden. And the wasted, deserted and ruined cities now are fortified and inhabited.** 36:36 **And the nations that are left all around you shall know that I Yahweh build the ruined places and plant that which was wasted. I Yahweh have spoken it, and I will do it.**

36:37 **So says the Lord Yahweh: yet this, I will be sought by the house of Israel to act for them. I will increase them with men like a flock.** 36:38 **As a holy flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her appointed feasts, so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men. And they shall know that I am Yahweh.**

Prophecy to the dry bones — confirmation of promised restoration

37:1 **The hand of Yahweh was on me,** and brought me by the Spirit of Yahweh, and made me rest in the midst of a valley, and it was full of bones. 37:2 And He made me pass among them all around. And behold, very many were on the face of the valley. And lo, *they were* very dry. 37:3 And he said to me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord Yahweh, You know. 37:4 Again He said to me, **Prophecy to these bones, and say to them, O dry bones, hear the Word of Yahweh.** 37:5 So says the Lord Yahweh to these bones: **Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live.** 37:6 And I will lay sinews on you, and will bring up flesh on you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and you shall live. **And you shall know that I am Yahweh.**

37:7 **So I prophesied as I was commanded.** And as I prophesied, there was a noise. And behold, a shaking! And the bones came near, a bone to its bone. 37:8 And I watched. And behold! The sinews and the flesh came up on them, and the skin covered them above. But *there was* no breath in them. 37:9 And He said to me, Prophecy to the Spirit, prophecy, son of man, and say to the Spirit, So says the Lord Yahweh: Come from the four winds, O Spirit, and breathe on these dead ones so that they may live.

Bones are the Whole House of Israel

37:10 **So I prophesied as He commanded me,** and the Spirit came into them, and they lived and stood on their feet, an exceedingly great army. 37:11 And He said to me, **Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel.** Behold, they say, Our bones are dried and our hope is lost; we are cut off by ourselves.

37:12 Therefore prophecy and say to them, So says the Lord Yahweh: Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up out of your graves, and will bring you into the land of Israel. 37:13 And you shall know that I am Yahweh when I have opened your graves, O My₃

people, and have brought you up out of your graves. 37:14 And I shall put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. And you shall know that I Yahweh have spoken and have done it, says Yahweh.

[Write on a stick — promise of a unified nation – ruled over by David & Yeshua](#)

37:15 **And the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,** 37:16 **And you, son of man, take a stick and write on it,** For Judah and for his companions, the sons of Israel. And take another stick and write on it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and all the house of Israel, his companions. 37:17 And join them to one another into one stick. And they shall become one in your hand. 37:18 And when the sons of your people shall speak to you, saying, Will you not declare to us what these *mean* to you? 37:19 Say to them, So says the Lord Yahweh: Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which *is* in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel, his companions, and I will put them with him, with the stick of Judah, and will make them one stick, and they shall be one in My hand. 37:20 And the sticks *on* which you write shall be in your hand before their eyes.

37:21 And say to them, So says the Lord Yahweh: ***Behold, I will take the sons of Israel from among the nations where they have gone, and will gather them on every side, and will bring them into their own land.*** 37:22 ***And I will make them one nation in the land on the mountains of Israel, and one King shall be king to them all.*** And they shall not still be two nations, nor shall they be divided into two kingdoms any more at all. 37:23 Nor shall they be defiled with their idols, even with their filthy idols, nor with all of their transgressions. ***But I will save them out of all their dwelling places, in them where they sinned, and will cleanse them. And they shall be to Me for a people, and I will be to them for God.***

37:24 ***And David My servant shall be King over them. And there shall be one Shepherd to all of them.*** And they shall walk in My judgments, and obey My Laws, and do them. 37:25 And

they shall dwell in the land that I have given to Jacob My servant, the land in which your fathers have lived. And they shall dwell in it, even they and their sons, and the sons of their sons for ever. ***And My servant David shall be their ruler forever.*** 37:26 ***And I will cut a covenant of peace with them. It shall be an everlasting covenant*** with them. And I will place them, ***and multiply them, and will set My sanctuary in their midst forever.*** 37:27 And My tabernacle shall be with them. ***Yea, I will be their God, and they shall be My people.*** 37:28 And the nations shall know that I Yahweh sanctify Israel, when My sanctuary shall be in their midst forever.

[Prophecy concerning Gog of Magog](#)

38:31 ***And the Word of Yahweh came to me, saying,*** 38:2 ***Son of man, set your face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief ruler of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal, and prophesy against him.*** 38:3 And say, So says the Lord Yahweh: Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the chief ruler of Rosh, Meshech and Tubal. 38:4 And I will turn you back, and put hooks into your jaws, and I will bring you out, and all your army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed most perfectly, a great assembly *with* buckler and shield, all of them swordsmen; 38:5 Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them, all of them *with* shield and helmet; 38:6 Gomer and all his bands; the house of Togarmah *from* the recesses of the north, and all his bands; *and* many peoples with you.

38:7 Be prepared; yea, prepare for yourself, you and all your assembly that are assembled to you, and be a guard to them. 38:8 After many days you will be visited. In the latter years you shall come into the land turned back from the sword, gathered out of many peoples, on the mountains of Israel, which have always been waste. (But he has been brought out of the peoples, and they shall dwell securely, all of them.) 38:9 And you shall go up, coming like a storm. You shall be like a cloud to cover the land,

you and all your bands, and many peoples with you.

38:10 So says the Lord Yahweh: And it shall be in that day that things shall come into your heart, and you shall devise an evil plan. 38:11 And you shall say, I will go up to the land of open spaces. I will go to those at ease, who dwell securely, all of them dwelling without walls, and there are no bars nor gates to them, 38:12 in order to take a spoil, and to steal a prize; to turn your hand on the inhabited waste places, and on the people gathered out of the nations, who have gotten cattle and goods, who dwell in the midst of the land. 38:13 Sheba and Dedan, and the merchants of Tarshish, with all their young lions, shall say to you, Have you come to take a spoil? Have you gathered your company to steal a prize, to carry away silver and gold, to take away cattle and goods, to take a great spoil?

[Prophecy against Gog](#)

38:14 ***So, son of man, prophesy and say to Gog, So says the Lord Yahweh:*** In that day when My people of Israel dwells securely, shall you not know *it*? 38:15 And you shall come from your place out of the recesses of the north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great company and a mighty army. 38:16 ***And you shall come up on My people Israel like a cloud, to cover the land. It shall be in the last days, and I will bring you against My land, so that the nations may know Me when I shall be sanctified in you, O Gog, before their eyes.***

38:17 So says the Lord Yahweh: Are you he of whom I have spoken in former days, by the hand of My servants the prophets of Israel, who prophesied in those days *and* years that I would bring you against them? 38:18 And it shall be on that day, when Gog comes against the land of Israel, says the Lord Yahweh, My fury shall come up in My face. 38:19 For in My jealousy *and* in the fire of My wrath I have spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great quaking in the land of Israel, 38:20 so that the fish of the sea, and the birds of the heavens, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all the men on the₄

face of the earth, shall quake at My presence. And the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.

38:21 And I will call for a sword against him on all My mountains, says the Lord Yahweh. **Each man's sword shall be against his brother.** 38:22 **And I will judge him with a plague and with blood. And I will rain on him, and on his bands, and on the many peoples with him, an overflowing shower, and great hailstones, fire and brimstone.** 38:23 So I will magnify Myself and sanctify Myself. And I will be known in the eyes of many nations, **and they shall know that I am Yahweh.**

39:1 **Therefore, son of man, prophesy against Gog and say, So says the Lord Yahweh:** Behold, I am against you, O Gog, the chief ruler of Rosh, Meshech and Tubal. 39:2 And I will turn you back, and lead you on. **And I will bring you up from the recesses of the north, and I will bring you on the mountains of Israel.** 39:3 And I will strike your bow out of your left hand, and will cause your arrows to fall out of your right hand. 39:4 You shall fall on the mountains of Israel, you and all your bands, and the people with you. I will give you for food to the birds of prey of every kind, and to the beasts of the field. 39:5 You shall fall on the face of the field, for I have spoken, says the Lord Yahweh.

39:6 And I will send a fire on Magog, and on the secure inhabitants of the coasts. And they shall know that I am Yahweh. 39:7 And I will make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel. And I will not let them profane My holy name any more. **And the nations shall know that I am Yahweh, the Holy One in Israel.**

39:8 Behold, it is coming, and it will be done, says the Lord Yahweh. This is the day of which I have spoken. 39:9 **And the inhabitants of the cities of Israel shall go out and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the javelins, and the spears. And they shall burn them with fire seven years.**

39:10 **so that they shall take no wood out of the field, nor cut down any out of the forests for they shall burn the weapons for fire.** And they shall plunder those who plundered them, and rob those who robbed them, says the Lord Yahweh.

39:11 **And it will be in that day I will give to Gog a place there, a grave in Israel,** the valley of those who pass by, east of the sea. And it shall stop the noses of those who pass by. And there they shall bury Gog and all his multitude. **And they shall call it, The Valley of the Multitude of Gog.** 39:12 **And the house of Israel shall bury them, to cleanse the land, seven months.** 39:13 And all the people of the land shall bury. And it shall be a name to them, the day when I am glorified, says the Lord Yahweh.

39:14 And men shall separate those who continually pass through the land, burying those who passed through, who remain on the face of the earth, to cleanse it. **At the end of seven months they shall search.** 39:15 And as they pass, those who pass through the land, and any man sees a bone, then he shall build a post beside it, until the buriers have buried it in **The Valley of the Multitude of Gog.** 39:16 And also the name of the city is The Multitude. And they shall cleanse the land.

39:17 **And you, son of man, So says the Lord Yahweh. Speak to the bird of every wing, and to every beast of the field: Gather yourselves and come; gather yourselves from all around to My sacrifice that I sacrifice for you, a great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel, so that you may eat flesh and drink blood.**

39:18 **You shall eat the flesh of the mighty and drink the blood of the rulers of the earth, of rams, lambs, goats, and bulls, all of them fatlings of Bashan.** 39:19 **And you shall eat fat until you are full, and drink blood until you are drunk, of My sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.** 39:20 **And you shall be filled at My table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, all the men of war, says the Lord Yahweh.**

39:21 And I will set My glory among the nations, and all the nations shall see My judgments which I have done, and My hand that I have laid on them. 39:22 **So the house of Israel shall know that I am Yahweh their God from that day and forward.** 39:23 **And the nations shall know that the house of Israel was exiled for their iniquity.** Because they sinned against Me, therefore I hid My face from them and gave them into the hand of their enemies. So they all fell by the sword. 39:24 According to their uncleanness and according to their sins I have done to them, and have hidden My face from them.

39:25 Therefore so says the Lord Yahweh: And I will return the captivity of Jacob, and will have mercy on the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for My holy name; 39:26 **after they have borne their shame and all their sins by which they have sinned against Me, when they dwell securely in their land and no one terrifies;** 39:27 when I have brought them again from the peoples, and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and am sanctified in them in the sight of many nations; 39:28 then they shall know that I am Yahweh their God who exiled them among the nations. But I have gathered them to their own land, and have not left any of them there. 39:29 **Nor will I hide My face from them any more, for I have poured out My Spirit on the house of Israel, says the Lord Yahweh.**
